



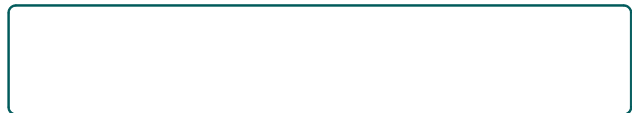
Impact of schizophrenia on the Thai economy: a cross-sectional study

Background: This study aimed to provide policy makers with important information with regard to care of schizophrenia patients in Thailand. Specifically, it aimed to (a) estimate the economic burden of schizophrenia; (b) identify prioritized and effective schizophrenia treatments; and c) explore patients' and clinicians' perspective of schizophrenia outcomes.
